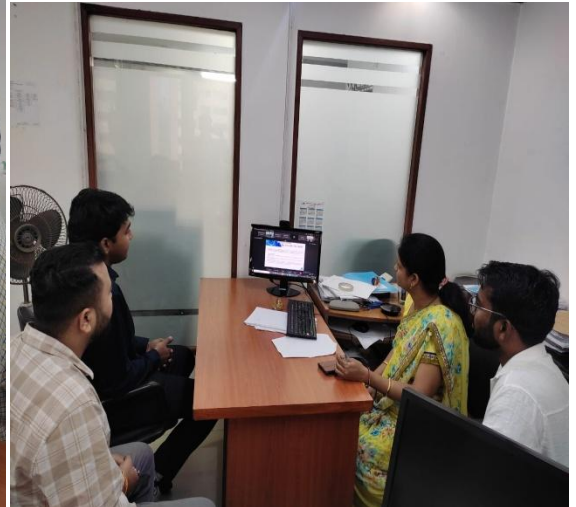
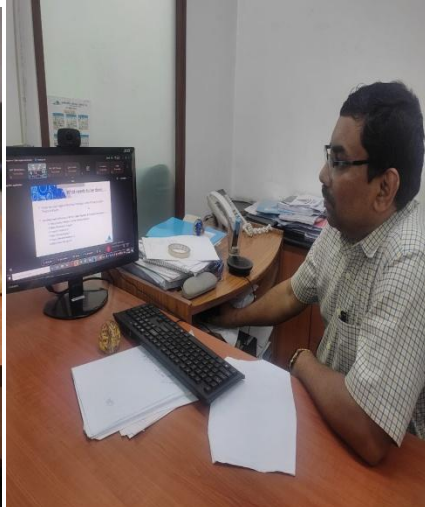

Cyber hygiene best practices

- Installing antivirus and malware software tools and scanning for viruses
- Using firewalls to stop unauthorized users from getting information
- Updating apps, web browsers, and operating systems on all devices regularly
- Keeping hard drives clean by reformatting and wiping them
- Changing passwords and using multifactor authentication
- Audit the company's cyber security technology to determine what malware protections and spam filters the company has and their condition.
- Do not allow employees to use their own devices for company work and prohibit them from using company-issued devices for personal use as well.

"CIA TRIAD"

2. Integrity
What It Is: Making sure that information is accurate and hasn't been tampered with or altered without authorization.
Why It Matters: To ensure that data remains trustworthy and reliable and that no unauthorized changes have been made.
How It's Achieved: Using checksums, digital signatures(Ex. Form-16 etc) , and hashing (creating a unique digital fingerprint of data) to detect any unauthorized changes or corruption.

3. Availability
What It Is: Ensuring that information and resources are accessible when needed.
Why It Matters: To make sure that users can get to their data and services without interruptions.
How It's Achieved: By implementing measures like backups, redundant systems, and disaster recovery plans to minimize downtime and maintain access even during failures or attacks.
